

**Faith Formation Rules and Expectations**

1. Students will come to class prepared and ready to learn. In addition to the textbooks, each student should have a pen and lined paper.
2. Students must be respectful of the teacher and each other. We will speak in turn and listen to each other. Mean speech or ridicule will not be tolerated.
3. Students will participate fully in prayer and discussion. No homework from school during class. ABSOLUTELY NO CELL PHONE USE. Phones will be confiscated if used. Side conversations and staring into space are also prohibited.
4. Dress can be casual but should be modest. No super-short shorts; no exposed skin or underwear between top and bottom; no spaghetti straps; no foul or racist print; no hats during class.
5. Families should observe the Third Commandment. The Sunday readings will be a part of every class. Confirmandi (those preparing for Confirmation) need to be part of the worshipping community. This means MASS EVERY SUNDAY (or Sat. evening). If you have athletic or other commitments on Sunday morning, plan to attend Saturday evening. Several neighboring parishes also have Sunday evening Mass. Parents are encouraged to attend with their children so they can discuss the issues we deal with in class.
